#### **SCHOOL MEALS AND SCHOOL MILK**

School meals will cost **£2.60 per day (£13 per week)** and must be paid for on a weekly basis every Monday morning. School milk is currently **20p** per day and can be paid for in full at the beginning of the school year (**£39**) or at the beginning of the September, January, and April terms. (£13 per term).
